Morland Choristers' Camp

has taken place every year since 1971, giving choristers the chance to sing all sorts of music and have lots of fun in a holiday atmosphere. The 40th Camp will take place in the week July 25th-August 1st, 2010.

*The **Taste of Morland** weekend is intended as an introduction to Camp for children aged 6-12, but it has taken on a life of its own as well.*

We have room for up to 40 children and we try to have equal numbers of boys and girls. Once again we will be singing under the expert guidance of Donald Gillthorpe, and the accompanist will be Daniel Brett. Both of them are very well-known at Camp and at Taste of Morland, and their enthusiasm shines out!

First practice will be on the Saturday morning at 9.30.

In the afternoons we will have outdoor activities which everyone so much enjoys at Camp. Dam-building and sports always seem to be popular.

On the Saturday evening we will give an informal concert. There might be a chance for you to play or sing your party-piece, so bring your instruments and music with you. Get all the family to put the date and time (6.00 pm) in their diaries now.

At 2 pm on the **Sunday afternoon**, to finish our weekend, we will sing at a service at Morland church. This will be a special 'Taste of Morland' service, and we do hope that all your family and friends will be able to come to that.

For security, feeding, etc. we want there to be a nominated adult – parent, teacher, choir trainer – responsible for each child. (One adult can be responsible for more than one child.) We usually find that these people are very keen to make themselves useful, boosting the singing and seeing to the meals as well as looking after the children in their free time.

For lunch on both days, we ask you to bring enough food for you and your children to eat and we will pool it as a Jacob's Join meal.

We will provide drinks and also a cooked meal at teatime on the Saturday. Julia Evans will be in touch with some local mums with a view to getting some contributions towards this meal. (Expenses will be paid.)

Everything costs money!

There will be a charge of £25 per child to cover tutors, music, food and administration.
