He trained as a singer and conductor at Lancaster University, graduating in 2006 and receiving the Denis McCaldin Performance prize for that year. His experience as a conductor is wide-ranging: from symphony orchestras and choral societies to wind bands and musical theatre. At his school in Lancaster, he leads a thriving department which boasts seven choirs, including a large boys' choir and a robed chapel choir.

As well as school and his work with the choirs of Lancaster Priory, Don is also in demand as a choral animateur, leading workshops and residential courses nationwide with singers of all ages. We know him here in Morland as Director of Church Music for the Morland Choristers' Camp, and he also teaches choral conducting for Sing for Pleasure.
