## The Morland SCD Weeks

Scottish Country Dancing has been part of the Morland scene for many years, and our regular summer dancing week is a popular feature of that. In 2014 we introduced a weekend event for those who are new (or relatively new) to Scottish Country Dancing. In October, 2018 we will hold the fourth such weekend.

## Plan for the weekend

Our plan is that the weekend should be fun as well as instructive. Anybody who fancies 'having a go' and anybody who has perhaps been to a few sessions of dancing is welcome to join us. People who might regard themselves as 'intermediate' will also be welcome. If a few established dancers care to come as well, they would be very useful in helping the others along. You don't need to bring a partner but it might be that some experienced dancers will see this as an opportunity to get their 'other half' into dancing.

## Instructor

Geoff Entwistle from Carlisle has firmly established himself as the right person to run such a weekend. He is well-known for leading dancing and walking holidays in various places and he shares the running of the regular class in Carlisle. He is particularly known for his cheerful and easy manner as well as being a very experienced dancer himself. He doesn't expect miracles, but he does succeed in getting people to do far more than they ever thought they could!

We will use recorded music from Geoff's huge library of SCD recordings. It goes without saying that only the best recordings have found a place there!

## Timetable

We would expect to gather at Newby End Farm for a meal at 6.00 pm on the **Friday**. The evening's dancing will run from 7.30 to 10.00. Geoff will find out what we can already

do and take us further along the road of steps and figures.

On the **Saturday** morning, we will pick up where we left off, dancing from 9.30 to 12 noon (with a break in the middle).

After lunch we'll have some free time (for a walk or a rest!), and then dance again from 3.30 to 5.00.

Dinner will be at 6.00, and then we dance from 7.30 to 10.00 (with tea-break). We hope that some will bring their party-pieces to perform, so that this evening can be rather more of a ceilidh.

**Sunday** morning will be as Saturday morning, and the final dancing session will be from 1.30 to 3.00. After a cup of tea, we disperse.

## Footwear

If you have seen people dancing SCD, you'll have noticed that they wear special shoes. If you've already done some dancing, you have perhaps already acquired some. If you have a look at the James Senior website (<http://www.jamessenior.co.uk/>), you'll see that the men usually wear ghillie shoes and the ladies simple dancing pumps.

If you don't have these, you'll find it best if you can bring some light shoes with smooth non-stick soles. (Sandals don't really work: they are not firm enough around your feet and their rubber or crepe soles will tend to grip too much on the floor.)

## Accommodation

We have, at Newby End Farm, a **caravan and camp site** with showers, washhouse, WC, electric hook-ups, Elsan disposal point and free Broadband. This is available throughout the season and you are welcome to extend your stay before or after the SCD Weekend (but do please book if you wish to do this.)

There is also some B&B accommodation available. Let us know what you would like!
