The Morland SCD Weeks

2018 will see the 11th of our d-i-y SCD Weeks, following the 21 years of weeks with John Drewry. These weeks are intended for experienced dancers. [There is also a weekend, October 19th - 21st, 2018, for those new (or comparatively new) to Scottish Country Dancing.] *In response to requests, we have extended the programme this year. Please see below.*

Workshops and dances

For those who have not been on the d-i-y weeks, we need to explain that all the teaching and dance instruction is done by the participants attending the week. All who run the sessions are experienced Class teachers and/or RSCDS instructors.

For the evening social dances, we are delighted that Robert Whitehead will be here again to play for us. Nobody encourages good dancing more than he does! The evening dance programmes will be circulated in time for you to have a look at them so that it will not be necessary to walk through all the dances.

For the morning workshops, the teachers arrange for their own recorded music. It goes without saying that the music is of the highest quality and is thoroughly danceable!

Programme

In response to requests to spread things out a little, **we will start this year on the Sunday evening, May 27th**, but there will be no morning workshops on the Wednesday. As ever, our final dance will be on the Friday evening, but most people will want to stay over until the Saturday.

On the other mornings there will be workshops, and all afternoons are free, giving you the opportunity to explore the area or take a rest.

The morning sessions will be split into two, the first to teach new or complicated dances; the second to prepare some of the evening dances.

On the Wednesday evening, after the dance, we will have our usual party, so please come armed with your favourite party pieces.

We welcome visitors to our evening sessions, but as space is limited, we cannot have extras in the mornings. If there was more room, we'd have more people here full-time! If you know anybody who would like to join us for an evening, please get them to let me know in advance. The price for an evening session is £7.50.

Saturday Dance

The Penrith SCD group will again organise a dance in the village hall on Saturday May 26th - the day before our week begins. You may wish to extend your stay to include this date.

Accommodation and meals.

We have, at Newby End Farm, a **caravan and camp site** with showers, washhouse, WC, electric hook-ups, Elsan disposal point and free Broadband. This is available throughout the season and you are welcome to extend your stay before or after the Country Dance Week, **but do please book!** Bank Holidays are busy times.

For those who prefer **bed-and-breakfast**, we have a limited number of places in or near Morland where this can be arranged at a price of £30.00 per head per night. There are also several self-catering cottages nearby. Please ask for details if this is what you fancy.

For **lunches**, caravanners and campers may like to fend for themselves, but there is an excellent café in Morland (closed on Tuesdays), and several pubs and garden centres around the area where good meals can be had.

Dinners - the plan is for us all to eat together on the first evening at 5.30 pm for 6.00 pm. This is included in the season ticket price. For the rest of the week, dinners are available at £13 each.
